

FIXIN THE COAST

TRAP RENTAL AGREEMENT

This Trap Rental Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into between Fixin The Coast ("FTC") and the undersigned Trap Borrower ("Borrower").

The purpose of this Agreement is to ensure the humane trapping, sterilization, vaccination, and return of community cats through Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) programs serving Harrison County and surrounding areas. FTC provides humane live traps for temporary use to assist with TNR efforts.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Humane Use of Traps

The Borrower agrees to use all traps in a safe, humane, and lawful manner consistent with accepted TNR practices.

2. Notification of Trapped Cats

The Borrower shall notify an FTC volunteer when a cat has been trapped and provide a photograph of the cat in the trap.

3. Veterinary Care

The Borrower shall transport trapped cats only to FTC-approved veterinary clinics unless prior approval is obtained from FTC.

4. Return of Cats

The Borrower agrees that all healthy community cats shall be returned to the location where they were originally trapped following surgery and recovery. Proof of return may be requested in the form of photographs or video.

5. Prohibited Activities

The Borrower shall not:

- Injure, abuse, abandon, or kill any trapped cat.

- Use traps for any purpose other than TNR activities.
- Relocate trapped cats without prior authorization from FTC.
- Transfer traps to another person without FTC approval.

6. Trap Monitoring and Care

The Borrower agrees to:

- Check traps frequently while traps are set.
- Provide protection from extreme weather conditions.
- Never leave a trapped animal unattended overnight.
- Cover traps after capture to reduce stress on the animal.
- Ensure trapped animals receive appropriate care while awaiting transport.

7. Rental Period

The Borrower shall return all traps within fourteen (14) days of receipt unless an extension is approved by FTC. One seven-day extension may be granted upon request. Additional time may be approved due to weather conditions or special circumstances.

8. Security Deposit

A security deposit of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) per trap is required at the time of rental. The security deposit will be fully refunded upon the return of each trap to Fixin The Coast, provided the trap is returned:

- Within the agreed rental period or approved extension period;
- In the same condition as when rented, excluding normal wear and tear; and
- With all original components intact.

If a trap is returned damaged beyond normal wear and tear, lost, stolen, altered, or otherwise rendered unusable, Fixin The Coast may retain all or part of the security deposit to cover repair or replacement costs.

9. Lost, Stolen, or Damaged Traps

The Borrower is responsible for the care and safekeeping of all traps while in their possession. If a trap is lost, stolen, or damaged beyond normal wear and tear, the Borrower forfeits the associated security deposit and may be responsible for any additional repair or replacement costs that exceed the deposit amount.

All traps remain the property of Fixin The Coast.

10. Recovery of Traps

FTC reserves the right to retrieve its traps immediately if FTC reasonably believes the traps are being misused, neglected, or used in a manner that endangers animals.

11. Right to Refuse Service

FTC reserves the right to refuse trap rentals to any individual at its sole discretion.

HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

The Borrower acknowledges that trapping, handling, transporting, and releasing animals involves inherent risks, including but not limited to animal bites, scratches, injuries, disease exposure, property damage, and other unforeseen hazards.

In consideration for the use of traps and participation in programs sponsored or supported by Fixin The Coast, the Borrower voluntarily assumes all risks associated with such activities and agrees to release, waive, discharge, hold harmless, and indemnify Fixin The Coast, its officers, directors, volunteers, agents, representatives, and affiliates from any

and all claims, demands, causes of action, liabilities, damages, losses, judgments, costs, and expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees, arising out of or related to:

- The use, possession, transportation, or operation of any trap provided by Fixin The Coast;
- The trapping, handling, transportation, treatment, care, or release of any animal;
- Any injury, illness, death, or damage suffered by the Borrower, any third party, any animal, or any property;
- The Borrower's negligence, misconduct, or violation of this Agreement; or
- Any claim brought by a third party arising from the Borrower's participation in trapping or TNR activities.

The Borrower further agrees that Fixin The Coast makes no warranties, express or implied, regarding the condition, suitability, or fitness of any trap for a particular purpose and accepts the trap "AS IS."

This Hold Harmless and Indemnification Agreement shall remain in effect during the trap rental period and thereafter with respect to any claims arising from activities conducted during the rental period.
